DIRECTIONS TO HEADQUARTERS HOTEL & SENECA LAKE STATE PARK

From North: Hwy 81 South to NYS Thruway, I-90 West to exit 42 Geneva. See**

From East: Take I-90 West (NYS Thruway) to exit 42 Geneva. See **

From West: Take I-90 East (NYS Thruway) to exit 42 Geneva. See **

**** North, East & West:** After Thruway exit make a Right on 14 S. Go approximately 5.5 miles into Geneva. Turn Left on Castle Street. Go straight through traffic light (at Lakefront St & 5 & 20) directly into Ramada Parking lot.

From South: Route 14 North to Routes 5 & 20 East. Follow Rts 5 & 20 (0.5 miles) miles, turn Right into Ramada.

To Show Site: Follow ** directions, but make a Left at traffic light. Seneca Lake State Park on Right. Follow the signs.

Turn Left onto Steward Ave. Turn Right onto Campus Rd.

RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE — New York State requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

PICNIC TABLES & GRILLS AVAILABLE — The Park has a number of picnic and grill area combinations for your use. Seneca State Park has a "Carry In, Carry Out" rubbish law. Please be advised when picnicking.

UNENTERED DOGS, SHADE TENTS & X-PENS must be at least 20 feet back from the ring during show hours. Chairs will be allowed at ringside but no x-pens or tents (exception will be tent for judges ringside mentoring and show videographer with narrator).

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS !!!!! NO DOGS IN LOBBY. YOUR DOGS MUST BE CONTROLLED AT ALL TIMES. No flex-leads are to be used in and around the hotel for the safety of your dogs and other hotel guests. The Show Committee has designated the hotels as part of the show site. An Event Committee hearing may be held for any hotel complaint including but not limited to failure to clean up after your dog and destruction of the hotel property.

WAIVER — All persons attending this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Irish Wolfhound Club of America, Inc. or its member, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
